CFTOKEN	ColdFusion cookies set on the user's computer to tie them to a set of session variables. By default, these two cookies are persistent cookies and are set to never expire. ColdFusion, a product from Macromedia, is a popular and sophisticated set of products for building Web sites and serving pages to users.

Cookie Name	Purpose
cookie_assistant_enable_cookies	Set after a user clicks the Accept button on the cookie pop up that appears when the Home Page is loaded. Persistent cookie which expires after 356 days. Cookie Assistant enables us to comply with the new European Union cookie law.

We use a third party application called SpeakIT that enables visually impaired visitors to listen to the website. Listed below are the cookies set by SpeakIT:

JSESSIONID	This cookie contains a session identity code. Does not contain any personal data and not used to register which web sites the user visits.	Necessary for the service to work.	The cookie is deleted when you close the browser.
insipio.generator.functions	This cookie contains a number representing the user's settings, for example speed settings. Does not contain any personal data and not used to register which web sites the user visits.	Required if a user changes the settings to differ from default.	The cookies expires after 30 days

Cookie Name	Purpose
__utma	This cookie is used to determine unique visitors to the site and it is updated with each page view.
__utmb	This cookie is used to track when a visit starts and ends
__utmz	This cookie tracks where a visitor came from (search engine, search keyword, link)
