



## PHP's Coronavirus (Covid-19) Working in Tenanted Properties Procedure

**If you have been in contact with a person with a confirmed case of Covid-19 or you are showing symptoms (new and continuous cough, fever or change in smell/taste) you must self-isolate in-line with government guidelines.**

**When visiting tenanted properties, you must –**

- Sanitise or wash hands before visiting property.
- Wear a face covering at initial contact/access to property\*.
- Undertake a short questionnaire at front door to ensure household are not self-isolating or showing any symptoms of Coronavirus (Covid -19). **Do not enter property if household has a confirmed case of Covid-19, self-isolating or showing any Covid-19 symptoms. The only exception is if emergency works are required inside the property.**
- When works are complete sanitise working area and vacate property.
- Sanitise/wash hands after vacating property.

***\* If a 2m distance from others can be maintained and the tenant gives consent your face covering can be removed inside the property to help complete your task. If a 2m distance can not be maintained, or a tenant is particularly vulnerable/elderly a face covering must be worn at all times whilst in the property.***
